### 5. <u>COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC</u>

CCSP's 3rd grade math Academic Interventionist Cassandra BoodHoo discussed the exciting things the 3rd grade teachers were doing with their students. She also discussed the testing preparations and incentives. She mentioned the progress she has seen since COVID.

CCSP 3rd grade ELA teacher Ms. Dupont piggybacked on Ms. Boohoo's sentiments. She stated that this was the first year that the third grade was taking the NJSLA testing since COVID.
